

REQUIREMENTS FOR OBTAINING A FENCE PERMIT

1. Two (2) copies of a recent Plat of Survey indicating the proposed location of fence.
2. Permit application must be completed and signed, including permanent real estate index number (PIN) and construction type and cost.
3. Residential fencing not to exceed six (6) feet in height. When property abuts a commercial zone eight (8) feet is permitted if placed within ten (10) feet of that lot line. Fences not allowed in front yards past the building line.

NOTE:

- a. Corner sideyard fence limit is three (3) feet high within fifteen (15) feet of intersection of a street, driveway or sidewalk.
- b. Reverse-corner lot fences not allowed beyond required front setback and equal distance to rear yard of adjacent reverse corner lot.
- c. Fence section for screening patio, pool or dog runs permitted to eight (8) feet in height.
- d. The finished side of a fence to face the adjoining properties.
- e. Fence posts 42" deep.
