Public Informational Meeting – August 27, 2019

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City has prepared concept plans to construct a sidewalk along the east side of Wolf Road between the Palatine Frontage Road and the Prospect Heights METRA Station.

The project consists of two stages:

- A. North Section: Palatine Frontage Road to Old Willow Road
 - B. South Section: Old Willow Road to the METRA Station
- The City is seeking multiple opportunities for Federal Funding for construction.
 - The City has received Invest in Cook funding from Cook County to assist with Preliminary Engineering costs for the north section.
 - Various funding options for Phase II Design Engineering and construction are being pursued.
 - The City is looking for input from its residents and adjacent businesses regarding the proposed project.

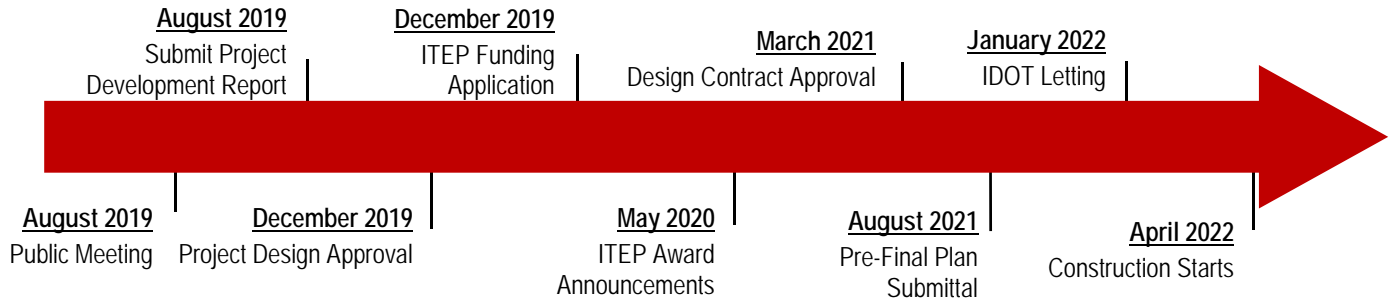
KEY PROJECT NOTES

- Improvements are anticipated to include a new concrete sidewalk five (5) feet wide.
- Enclose the open ditch adjacent to Wolf Road north of Old Willow Road.
- Provide crosswalks at all intersections and major access drives.
- Provide pedestrian signals at signalized intersections.
- Provide a gated crossing of the METRA railroad tracks between Camp McDonald Road and the METRA Station.
- If Federal Funding is secured for Design Engineering, design of the roadway improvements would likely occur during Spring and Summer of 2021.
- If Federal Funding is secured for Construction the project would likely start in Spring 2022.

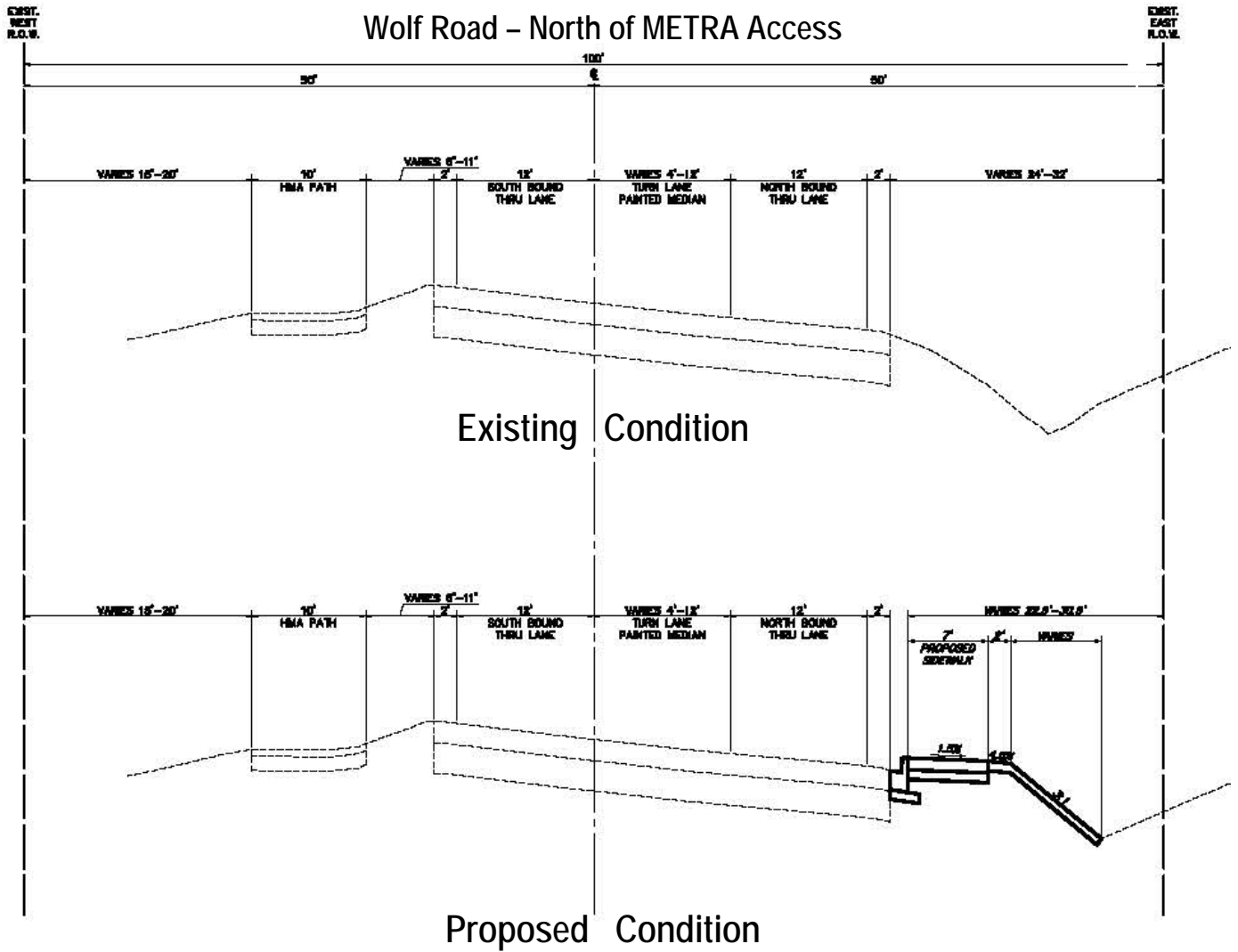
PROJECT STUDY AREA
