Hi neighbor, this isn't a 'sales' solicitation. **Why am I contacting you?** I'm also contacting our other neighbors in the Shawn, Thierry, Claire “LOOP”. First I'll briefly introduce myself. I'm Bob Korvas and live at 207 Thierry with my Wife Kathy since 1984. I've previously served a number of years on the Prospect Heights Zoning Board and own an Insurance brokerage agency since 1980.

***I'm looking for people that want city water now.*** If you're like us and other neighbors I've spoken to (that is **tired of paying for the expenses of hard well water** like: low pressure, deeper wells and maintenance, ruined clothes, rust stains, broken down plumbing, water softeners, salt treated water, you name it...add your favorite to the list), than you'll like to know about what we can do. Imagine what getting city water will do for you? (Easier resale and increased home values for one.)

***What makes this opportunity exciting?*** It doesn't require everyone. City water is in the works for new homes less than 300 feet from our 'LOOP'. Funding a study to hook up other existing homeowners adjacent to us has already started. Now it's our turn. We can **have city water without having to wait** for a vote. Best of all, it won't matter that everyone does not want it now. Neighboring homes that don't join in now will simply pay more if they hook up later. I'll explain more if you're ready to act and contact me.

If you have been disappointed like us by the previous referendum voting results, negative comments and confusion by those that don't support city water, than this is the answer.

You can't *expect to get the city water by waiting*; it's not going to happen.
