Prospect Heights Water feasibility petition Lake Claire/Shires Loop

Submitted to: Mayor Rodney Pace and the City council of Prospect Heights

Honorable Mayor Rodney Pace and Alderman of the City of Prospect Heights,

We the Lake Claire and Shires subdivision property owners are overwhelming interested in the feasibility of obtaining Lake Michigan Water for property owners as illustrated on the area map diagram. The enclosed petition and accompanying documents are submitted to you as proof.

We held an open meeting in the Borland room of the Prospect Heights Library at 6:45 pm, on December 27<sup>th</sup>, 2006. At that time we listened to testimony of Jean Williams (30 year resident and respected professional real-estate expert), Don Gould (Prospect Heights Fire Chief and resident of our community) and Adam Boche (Prospect Heights Public Works Director). Also in attendance was 4th ward alderman Pat Ludvigsen. We held an open debate discussing the issues and concerns of obtaining Lake Michigan Water. All Lake Claire and Shires Community members in attendance voted unanimously to go forward with the projects feasibility and to collect additional signatures on petitions from the remaining property owners as described in this submission. The attendance sheets, petitions, and accompanying documents represent the result that over 80% agree to go forward as follows.

We the acting Officers, Chairman and Committee members of the Lake Claire / Shires subdivisions community propose that upon approval by the City Council of Prospect Heights and with cooperation and approval of our representatives create, develop and implement a plan to obtain Lake Michigan water for our community.

Our proposed plan would bring water by means of new construction from the existing connection on Camp McDonald Road (south side Rob Roy) westerly to Wheeling Rd, northerly to Shawn Ln, easterly if possible and either by easement, or other acceptable means of engineering to include Galway Dr, Waterford Dr, New Castle Ln up to and including 206 Coldren Dr, then westerly by easement across the park along Claire Ln until a loop is completed and connected on Wheeling Rd. The distance encompasses approximately 11,000 linear feet. Should We (City council and our appointed board) come to agreement as to the scope, design and cost of the project and area as described, we agree in principal that funding be by SSA property tax.

Please respond to this submission as to whether it is submitted on our behalf at the January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2006 city council session and when, or if, it will become part of the City of Prospect Heights agenda. Please address you response to my home or office.
